



SWEET, a European Commission Horizon 2020 funded project, is supported by a consortium of 29 pan-European research, consumer and industry partners, who are developing and reviewing evidence on long term benefits and potential risks involved in switching over to alternate sweeteners and sweetness enhancers (S&SEs) to replace sugars, in the context of public health and safety, obesity, and sustainability.

Our five year multidisciplinary project engages stakeholders from across the food chain - consumers, patients, health professionals, scientists, policy makers, and regulators - to address the role of sweeteners in weight control, and potentially move viable products to market.
